

It's interesting

The hystory of the carol *Silent Night* is quite contradictory. The traditional story is that Josef Mohr, an Austrian priest and his friend Franz Xavier Gruber wrote it in 1816 in Oberndorf, Austria, on Christmas Eve when they discovered the church organ was broken. The music to *Silent Night* was therefore intended for a guitar. However, recent evidence indicates this may be only folklore. An old manuscript has reportedly been discovered that shows Franz X. Gruber wrote the score 2–4 years after Mohr had written the lyrics. The song was translated from German into English in 1863 by John Freeman Young, an American Bishop. Whatever the truth, this Christmas carol has been a favourite worldwide for almost 200 years.
