# Открытый урок английского языка в 11 классе по теме "Твоя будущая профессия"

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рок разработан с применением современных компьютерных технологий. Урок проводится в 11 классе, в качестве вводного к разделу "A job for life?" учебника английского языка для 11 класса "New Millennium English". Так как урок является вводным, соответственно ставится и **цель урока**: формирование знаний по теме "Твоя будущая профессия" и умений оперировать ими. Главная цель урока включает следующий практический компонент: совершенствование практических навыков владения лексикой по теме путем привлечения дополнительного материала, развитие навыков восприятия речи на слух и навыков чтения с целью основного и полного понимания прочитанного, развитие навыков аудирования и говорения, развитие ассоциативной памяти, внимания и быстрой реакции. Решение практического компонента цели способствует реализации воспитательного компонента: создание условий для формирования у обучающихся уважения и интереса к учению, оказание помощи в осознании и выборе профессионального пути. Для реализации вышеперечисленных целей используется аутентичный и актуальный материал учебника, специальные технические информационные и языковые средства; учитываются личностные характеристики учащихся: сообразительность, интерес, творческие способности, взаимопонимание и взаимопомощь. На уроке реализуется принцип коммуникативной направленности и для его осуществления используются фронтальные, индивидуальные, парные и групповые формы работы. Урок готовится в рамках тематической презентации, выполненной в программе "Power point" (см. Приложение). Такая форма применения информационных технологий помогает четко выстраивать структуру урока, наглядно показывать этапы работы учителя и учеников, эстетически оформлять урок. Кроме этого, применение компьютерной презентации и электронных учебников помогает облегчать процесс обучения, освобождая учителя от долгих объяснений, а также делает урок динамичным и живым.


























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
