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Интерактивная игра по теме “Christmas traditions”

Интерактивная игра, состоящая из четырех конкурсов, рассчитана на учащихся 4-х классов. Конкурсные задания по страноведению выполняются в режиме *on-line* с использованием интерактивной доски. Конкурсы различных уровней сложности позволяют даже не очень сильному ученику почувствовать вовлеченность в игру, а соревновательный момент захватывает внимание ребят.

Цель: Знакомство с традициями празднования Рождества в Великобритании и других странах.

Задачи:

1. Расширение кругозора учащихся по страноведческому материалу.
2. Воспитание уважительного отношения к культуре, традициям и обычаям народов других стран.
3. Развитие навыков групповой деятельности.
4. Развитие творческих способностей учащихся через игровую деятельность.
5. Развитие и поддержание интереса к изучению иностранного языка.

Оснащение: интерактивная доска, подключение к Интернету, работа в режиме *on-line* с сайтом www.britishcouncil.org/learnenglish

Предварительная работа

Подготовка к игре начинается с начала декабря. Учащиеся получают вопросы, по которым они готовятся к игре. При подготовке они пользуются различными источниками информации. На уроках английского языка (в течение 5–10 минут) разучаиваются рождественские песни, учащиеся учатся подписывать рождественские открытки. Ближе к 25 декабря с учащимися 4-х классов проводится интерактивная игра.

Развитие компетенций

1. Развитие учебно-познавательной и компенсаторной компетенций

Развитие умений и навыков:

- соотносить графический образ слова с его звуковым образом в процессе чтения и письма;

- опираться на языковую догадку в процессе чтения текстов, содержащих отдельные незнакомые слова или новые комбинации знакомых слов;
- действовать по образцу и по аналогии при выполнении упражнений.

2. Развитие социокультурной компетенции:

- Знакомство с традициями и проведением праздника Рождества в Великобритании и других странах;
- развитие умения воспроизводить наизусть небольшие простые, изученные произведения детского фольклора (стихи, песни) на английском языке;
- создание собственных поздравительных открыток.

3. Развитие языковой компетенции:

- знать основные правила чтения;
- адекватно произносить и различать на слух все звуки английского языка;
- соблюдать долготу и краткость гласных;
- не оглушать звонкие согласные в конце слов;
- не смягчать согласные перед гласными;
- соблюдать словесное и фразовое ударение, членение предложения на смысловые группы;
- соблюдать интонацию утвердительного, вопросительного и побудительного предложений, а также предложений с однородными членами.

4. Развитие речевой компетенции:

- воспроизводить выученные песни;
- различать на слух звуки, звукосочетания, слова, предложения на английском языке;
- различать на слух интонацию и эмоциональную окраску фраз;
- воспринимать и понимать речь учителя и одноклассников в процессе диалогического общения;
- понимать на слух основное содержание небольших текстов (длительностью звучания не более 1–1,5 минут), построенных на знакомом языковом материале, с опорой на зрительную наглядность.

Steps

Teacher: Good afternoon, boys and girls! I'm glad to see you. We are here to have some fun. Would you like to play? That's great! To begin with I want to divide you into two teams. Each of the teams should choose the captain...

What's your favourite day? **Read and listen** to a boy telling us about Christmas, and find out about some of the things that people do for this holiday in the United Kingdom.





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5. Play a game

How to play: There are ten questions in this quiz. Read the question and choose the best answer — A, B or C. You'll get 2 points if you guess correctly first time, and 1 point if you guess correctly second time. How many points will you get? Try a quiz.
